### CHARLIE FARREN - Friday, Sep 8 - \$13M, \$15NM Also "Thank You Dinner" for our Silver and Gold Members – see the Membership insert for details.

Charlie Farren has long been known for great songs and great singing, and for outstanding live solo acoustic performances. Alone onstage with acoustic guitar in hand, Charlie captures an audience with his unique delivery, insightful lyrics, memorable songs, beautiful vocals and subtle and innovative guitar style. Charlie emerged onto the national scene in the early '80's after teaming with Aerosmith lead guitarist Joe Perry and releasing an acclaimed album on CBS. Reviewing a Farren performance at Club Passim, Tommy Dempsey of Soundcheck Magazine wrote that "Charlie is the kind of performer that when he's finished a show, you feel like you've connected with an old friend. Taking requests from fans, engaging in funny banter about his age, and displaying a candor rarely demonstrated by former arena rock stars, it's clear he has not lost the ability to captivate a room full of people no matter what the size. " And R.J. Nickerson of New England Entertainment Digest wrote that "Charlie continues to be one of America's most original and compelling musical artists. He takes the stage alone - and leaves the stage with a roomful of new believers.

### COFFEEHOUSE - Friday, Sep. 15 - \$5M, \$6NM

**Elizabeth and Dave Hanson**, aka "Been there done that" have been performing together as a duo for the last ten years. They consider themselves to be "vintage blues" slash "folk" in orientation. Dave likes to finger pick the guitar reminiscent of Mississippi John Hurt and Jammie Kokenen ("hot tuna"). Elizabeth's vocal influences include Eva Cassidy, Laura Nero, and of course Bonnie Raitt. We've heard bits and pieces of their repertoire at our Open Mike; tonight they'll be treating us to a whole set.

With long red hair and a Celtic harp, **Shelley Otis** seems to be one step away from Ireland or Scotland. In addition to Celtic music, Shelley, who is originally from rural Illinois, also plays a mountain dulcimer. Singing in a clear, simple voice, Shelley courts her audience in a laid-back and enchanting manner with folk songs from all over the world, modern popular tunes, and original compositions.

### SESSION AMERICANA - Fri, Oct. 6 - \$13 M, \$15 NM

Session Americana, the roots roundtable whose accidental beginning in a small Cambridge pub has grown into a local phenomenon, has drawn praise from fans (of all ages!), accolades from the press and has become a magnet for like-minded musicians who appreciate the spontaneity, simplicity, and devil-may-care attitude that makes the band so much fun to watch. The core group of Ry Cavanaugh, Sean Staples, Jimmy Fitting, Billy Beard, Dinty Child and Kimon Kirk sit in a circle around one microphone and play music from their memory, pulling out some old and some not-so-old nuggets steeped in the tradition of American blues, country, rock and folk -- the music that has become known as Americana. Fans such as Mark Erelli, Peter Mulvey, Peter Wolf and others have been known to stop by and sit in for a few songs with the band. Scott Alarik, of the Boston Globe wrote of them that "Their sound lives on the edge of exploration, where the freewheeling crackle of a great jam session meets the lean groove of classic country music. ### COFFEEHOUSE – Friday, Oct. 20 - \$5M, \$6

**Tim FitzPatrick**, active on the MASS Bluegrass scene for years, has branched out into Celtic folk and country music, and he's as facile and commanding in either genre. He delivers classic and contemporary material, including originals with a resonant, powerful voice. He can "turn you onto Celtic tunes, make you want to dance, get you thinking about an old love and turn you into a Hank Williams fan" – (JB Sweeney, Café Ziba producer) all in one night.

Opener **Tiffany Rozenas** has been studying violin for 8 years. Accompanied by her father, Bronie, Tiffany really shines on her Gaelic roots music. Not only adept at exploring the Celtic tradition, this fiddler extraordinaire delights audiences with her Bluegrass and Old Time styles as well.
